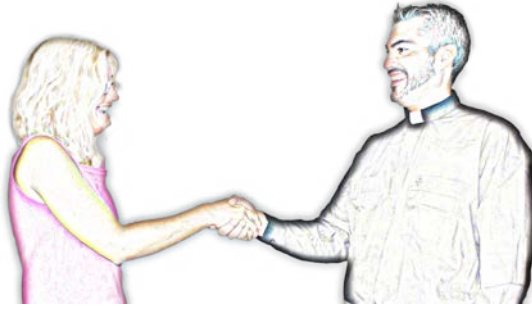

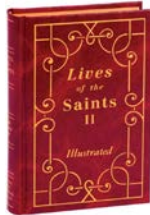
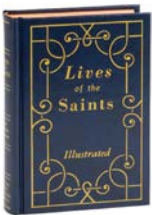

Making a long journey in 1537 to Italy the society was given papal approval for their order. Pope Paul the third permitted them to be ordained into the priesthood.
